Participation Agreement

GA-EPH is a non-profit organization for homeschoolers. As an organization, we have no religious affiliation and welcome people of all belief systems, ethnic backgrounds, educational styles, and ages. GA-EPH is staffed by volunteers. We welcome the participation of every family. This Participation Agreement explains the policies and expectations of our program.

Program Information

· This is not a drop-off program.

- A parent or guardian must remain at Roberts School while their child(ren) attend classes. A parent or guardian must sign-in each Wednesday at the administration desk.
- You may make arrangements with other parents to be responsible for your children. If you leave while your child is still on the premises, you must provide the name of the parent on site responsible for your child(ren) and your contact information on the sign in sheet. Please make sure your child knows that you will be gone and which adult will be supervising them.
- We do not follow school system calendars. Please make sure you check the session dates. Classes will be canceled if Cobb County Schools are closed due to inclement weather. If possible, we will have a make-up day; however this is not always possible.
- Children are expected to be respectful, cooperative, and careful. GA-EPH staff will be notified of any behavior considered disrespectful, disruptive, or dangerous, and student will be asked to leave class or the building. A warning will be given to the parent. If a child receives three warnings, the child will not be permitted to attend class the following week. If behavior continues to be an issue, the instructor or GA-EPH may ask the student to withdraw from the class. A refund will not be issued.
- Please be on time to class. Tardiness is disrespectful to the instructor as well as the other students. Students arriving late disrupt the classes that have already begun.
- So as not to infringe on class time, communication with the instructors should be done between classes. If you would like to leave a note for an instructor, you may give it to a GA-EPH representative. Please remember that some instructors teach back to back classes. Please make sure you are not interrupting or delaying the start of the next class.
- No one will escort your child from one class to another. If your child needs to be escorted, you must do so.
- Parents and siblings may wait in the designated waiting area (waiting area, gazebo or basketball court).
- Playing in the parking lot is not allowed and warnings will be given.
- Most communication will be done by email. We also have a google group (<http://groups.google.com/group/ga-eph>) to communicate announcements and for families to discuss the program, homeschooling issues, and to get to know one another.

Enrollment and Financial Information

- Families that register and pay in full by the session due date will receive a **10% discount**.
 - Administration fees may be paid annually or by the session. **Administration Fees are nonaccumulative.**
 - Administration fees are non-refundable unless all registered classes are canceled before the session begins.
 - Families should register and pay for all classes through GA-EPH. Checks should be payable to GA-EPH. No money should be given to instructors.
 - Enrollment form and payment in full must be received by the session due date. It is important to register on time to prevent classes being canceled due to low enrollment.
- **No refunds will be given once a session begins.**
- Classes may be canceled if the required minimum is not met by the deadline. Refunds will be given if a class is canceled and you do not have a 2nd class choice for that time.
 - Students will not be allowed to drop one class in order to enroll in another after a session has begun unless you are willing to pay for both classes.
 - A \$35 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
 - If you have an unpaid balance, your child will not be allowed to attend class.

GA-EPH Rules

If rules are not followed, a warning will be given for any behavior considered disrespectful, disruptive, or dangerous. If a child receives three warnings, the child will not be permitted to attend class the following week. If behavior continues to be an issue, the instructor or GA-EPH may ask the student to withdraw from the class without a refund.

- Students must show respect to instructors, students, administration staff and other parents at all times.
- Keep noise levels down inside Roberts School.
- No running or rough play is allowed inside Roberts School.
- No cell phones, computers, mp3 players, video games or other items that may cause distractions are allowed in classrooms. These items will be taken from students and returned at the end of class.
- No playing in the parking lot. Children may play in the gazebo, the basketball court, or the grassy areas around the building.
- No Heelys, wheeled shoes are allowed inside Roberts School.
- No Ripstik, skates, scooters, bikes or skateboards are allowed inside Roberts School, sidewalks or in the parking lot.
- No tobacco, drugs, firearms, or alcohol will be allowed on the premises of Roberts School.
- No dogs or other animals are allowed inside Roberts School. Animals must be leashed and in the company of their owner while on the premises.
- No use of profanity, pornographic, discriminatory or any other offensive materials will be allowed on the premises of Roberts School.
- Be respectful of City of Acworth materials and property. **Clean up after yourself. We are our own cleanup crew.** Our rent does not include janitorial services.
- Neither the City of Acworth nor GA-EPH accepts any liability for your children.
- Neither the City of Acworth nor GA-EPH will be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- City of Acworth reserves the right to use Roberts School on short notice, which may result in classes being canceled. If this occurs, a prorated refund or credit will be issued at the end of the session.
